- Harvesting and packaging plants for sale and transport

- Develop a soil health and plant nutrition program.
- Keep records of soil mixtures, plantings and yields.
- Advise customers on plant care
- Supervise maintenance of property, machinery, and equipment.

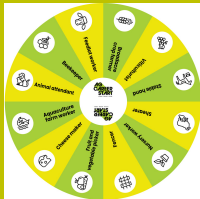
Production Horticulture Supervisor
